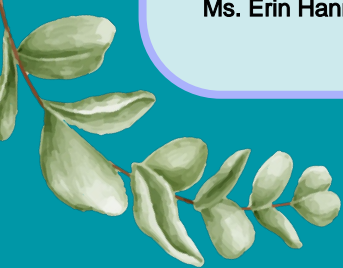

NEW STUDENT ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST



Parents/Guardians must enroll online and submit documentation for each student. Please be prepared to upload digital copies during the online enrollment process. **Students cannot attend school and Registrars cannot place students in classes until parents/guardians submit required paperwork and complete online enrollment.** Please visit: <http://www.eanesisd.net/enroll> to learn more about the enrollment process.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- **2 Proofs of Residency**
 - (1) Current signed lease, deed or contract, or most recent property tax receipt **AND**
 - (2) Current utility bill for the property in the parent/guardian's name.
- **Transfer Students:** Provide copy of acceptance e-mail/letter
- **Birth Certificate** State law requires schools to have proof of a child's identity and age on file.
- **Social Security Card** Preferred, but optional. If no social security card, please communicate to Registrar at time of enrollment.
- **Valid Driver's License** State law requires a driver's license or valid state ID. Eanes ISD requires that the ID have the same address as student's proof of residency. Parents/Guardians have 30 days from the date of registration to provide a license with the correct address.
- **Immunization Record** Immunizations must be up-to-date. EISD requires a copy of the child's immunization record or a completed EISD Certificate of Immunization form. The record must include the month, day and year for each vaccine and a physician signature or clinic stamp. Please visit: <http://www.dohs.state.tx.us/immunize/school> to learn more about immunization requirements and exemption information.

ADDITIONAL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS (IF APPLICABLE):

- **Special Education/ 504 Records** if applicable If a student receives Special Education or 504 services a copy of the current services records is required.

EMERGENCY CARE PLAN/ACTION PLAN

If your child has a condition that COULD require treatment at school, please: (1) notify the school nurse, (2) ask your child's doctor to complete an EISD emergency care plan/action plan that prescribes and authorizes treatment, (3) sign the form to authorize treatment, and (4) bring the form and medications to the school nurse before the first day of school. Examples include: anaphylaxis, asthma, diabetes, seizures and other chronic health conditions. Download EISD care/action plans at: <https://www.eanesisd.net/dept/health/forms>.

- **Allergy/Anaphylaxis Emergency Care Plan** This form must be completed by the child's physician if the child has a life-threatening allergy

- **Asthma Action Plan** This form must be completed by the child's physician if the child is being treated for asthma

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR STUDENTS ENTERING 6th – 12th GRADE:

- **Unofficial Copy of Transcript** If a student entering grades 7th through 12th has taken high school credit course an unofficial copy of the student's transcript is requested at time of enrollment.
- **Report Card** The most recently completed report card is required. ADDITIONAL REQUEST: Report cards from the previous 2 years for students entering grades 8th – 8th.
- **Standardized Test Scores** The most recent standardized test scores. ADDITIONAL REQUEST: Test scores from previous 2 years for students entering grades 8th – 8th.

REQUESTED DOCUMENT:

- **Physician's Report** A physical exam is strongly recommended when enrolling in Kindergarten.

ATTENDANCE

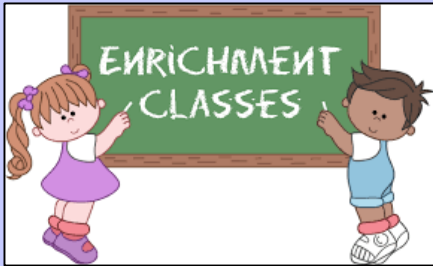

Eanes ISD Mission Statement

The Eanes community is vitally committed to educational excellence that prepares and inspires all students for life-long success by engaging each student in rigorous academic experiences and enriching opportunities.

Each elementary campus provides students with **art** , **physical education** , and **music** instruction. Students also attend monthly Social -Emotional Counseling classes with a certified **school counselor** . In addition, each campus also has a school **librarian** on staff. On-site student support and staff development are provided through **Educational Partners** on every elementary campus.

DISTRICT SAFETY

A critical component of safe schools is a uniform response to any incident. Weather events, fires, accidents, intruders and other threats to safety are scenarios that are planned and trained for by school and district staff.

- Each campus is equipped with **automatic locking exterior doors** , **cameras** that scan the property, and **emergency safety plans** .
- Visitors must ring a **doorbell** before gaining access to campuses.
- Eanes ISD utilizes the **RAPTOR System** for all visitors. This is a computer software system that enhances school security by reading visitor drivers' licenses, comparing information to a sex offender data base, alerting campus administrators if a match is found, then (assuming no match was made) printing Visitor badges that include a photo.
- **Employees** are **trained** , fingerprinted, and have a background check performed prior to employment..
